Alphabets & Basic Grammar

Alphabets & Basic Grammar are essential for language development. Children identify alphabets using objects, learn about small and capital letters, match them, understand vowels and consonants, practice phonic drills, explore vowel words, recognize rhyming words, and differentiate gender. These skills lay the groundwork for effective communication.

and written work, and includes supplementary activities like worksheets, storytelling, and enactment. This comprehensive approach enhances children's language development and proficiency.

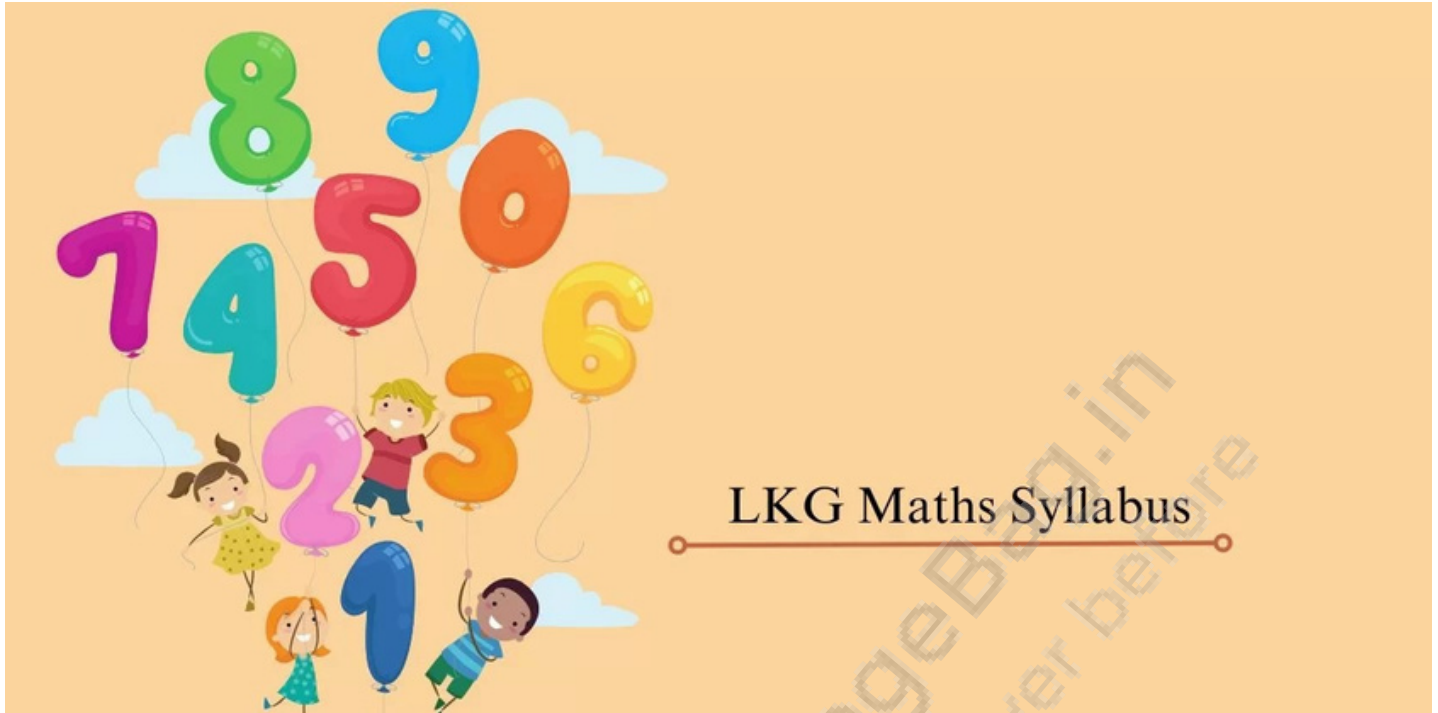

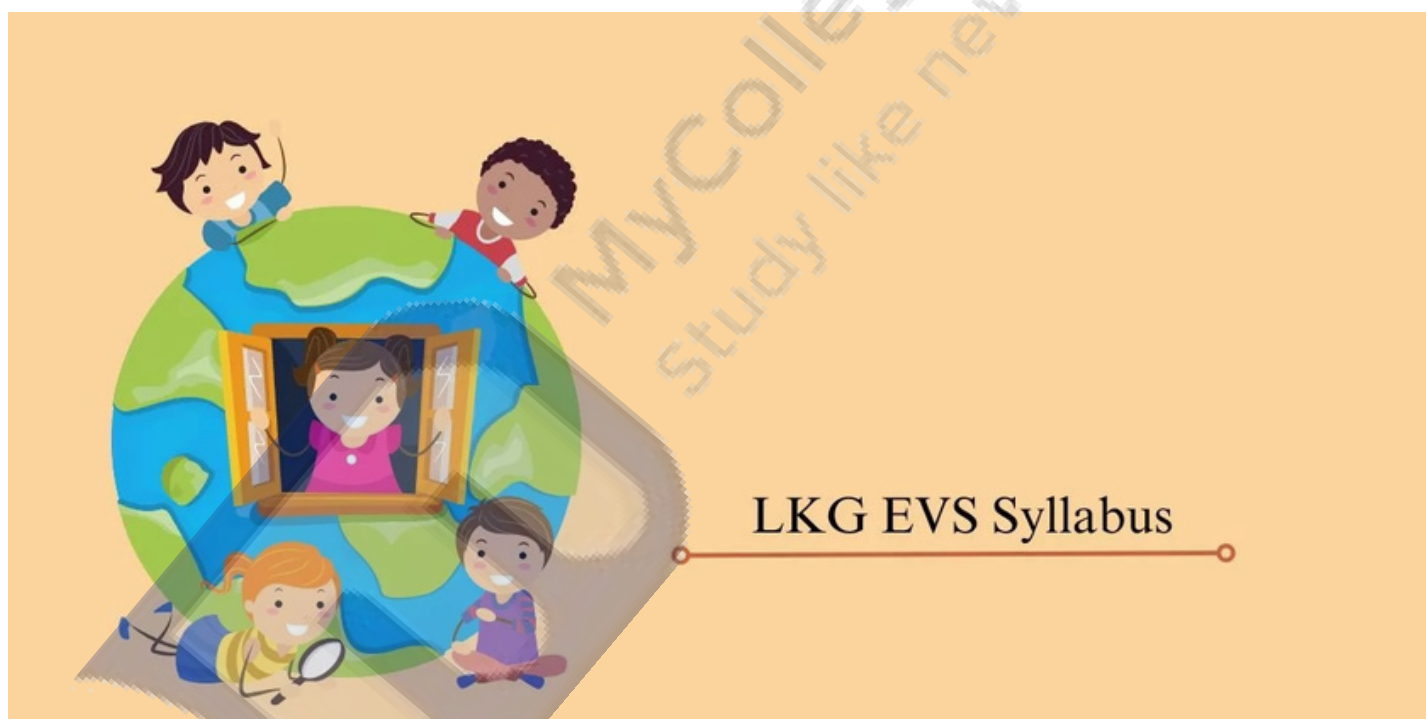
